A WORD FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

2025 was a year of meaningful transformation for Faith in Action Georgetown. With the steadfast support of our volunteers, donors, and community partners, we expanded our capacity, deepened our impact, and strengthened the relationships at the heart of our work.

A major milestone was the addition of two new-to-us vehicles, doubling our fleet and enabling the official launch of our Pathways rideshare program, now operating at full capacity. To support this growth, we added drivers so more older adults could access reliable transportation and maintain independence. We also reduced our office footprint, creating space for AGE of Central Texas to establish a Georgetown presence and further strengthen local services.

In February, we celebrated our 5th Annual Portraits of Independence with a lively Sock Hop-themed evening that raised vital funds while fostering connection. In March, our partnership with Mesquite Creek Outfitters returned for Amplify Wilco on the Square, featuring Name-That-Tune Bingo and a joyful celebration of community. Later in the year, our Choral Concert offered a powerful night of music and remembrance.

Faith in Action remained deeply engaged throughout the year—volunteering locally, supporting partners, and sharing our mission across Georgetown. From filling backpacks and assisting with the Christmas Stroll to supporting flood cleanup and welcoming Southwestern students, we continued to be neighbors caring for neighbors.

Our focus on clients never wavered. In 2025, we provided nearly 12,500 rides, cut our waitlist in half, and welcomed 162 new clients, while expanding client enrichment offerings that provide practical support, connection, and creative opportunities.

At its core, this year reaffirmed what we know to be true: Faith in Action is, and always will be, about relationships.

Assisting older adults in navigating and integrating opportunities in our community that make living a fulfilled and independent life possible.

Go Van Go remained a vital lifeline in 2025, providing more than 4,000 rides to approximately 100 individuals and helping remove transportation barriers that limit independence and quality of life.

More than transportation, Go Van Go supports health, dignity, and connection. Weekly grocery trips ensure access to fresh, nutritious food, while social outings keep clients active, engaged, and connected to their community.

These rides reduce isolation, strengthen routines that support physical and mental health, and help clients remain visible, involved, and valued. Thanks to dedicated staff, drivers, and supporters, Go Van Go continues to deliver opportunity, connection, and care—one ride at a time.

Go-Van-Go



Launched in early 2025, Pathways quickly became a critical support for clients with essential transportation needs. In its first year, the program provided more than 350 medical and errand rides to 184 individuals, helping ensure access to care and basic services that might otherwise have been out of reach.

From medical appointments and pharmacy visits to essential errands, Pathways reduces barriers that impact health, independence, and stability. Through reliable, compassionate transportation, the program empowers clients to manage daily needs with greater confidence, continuity, and peace of mind.

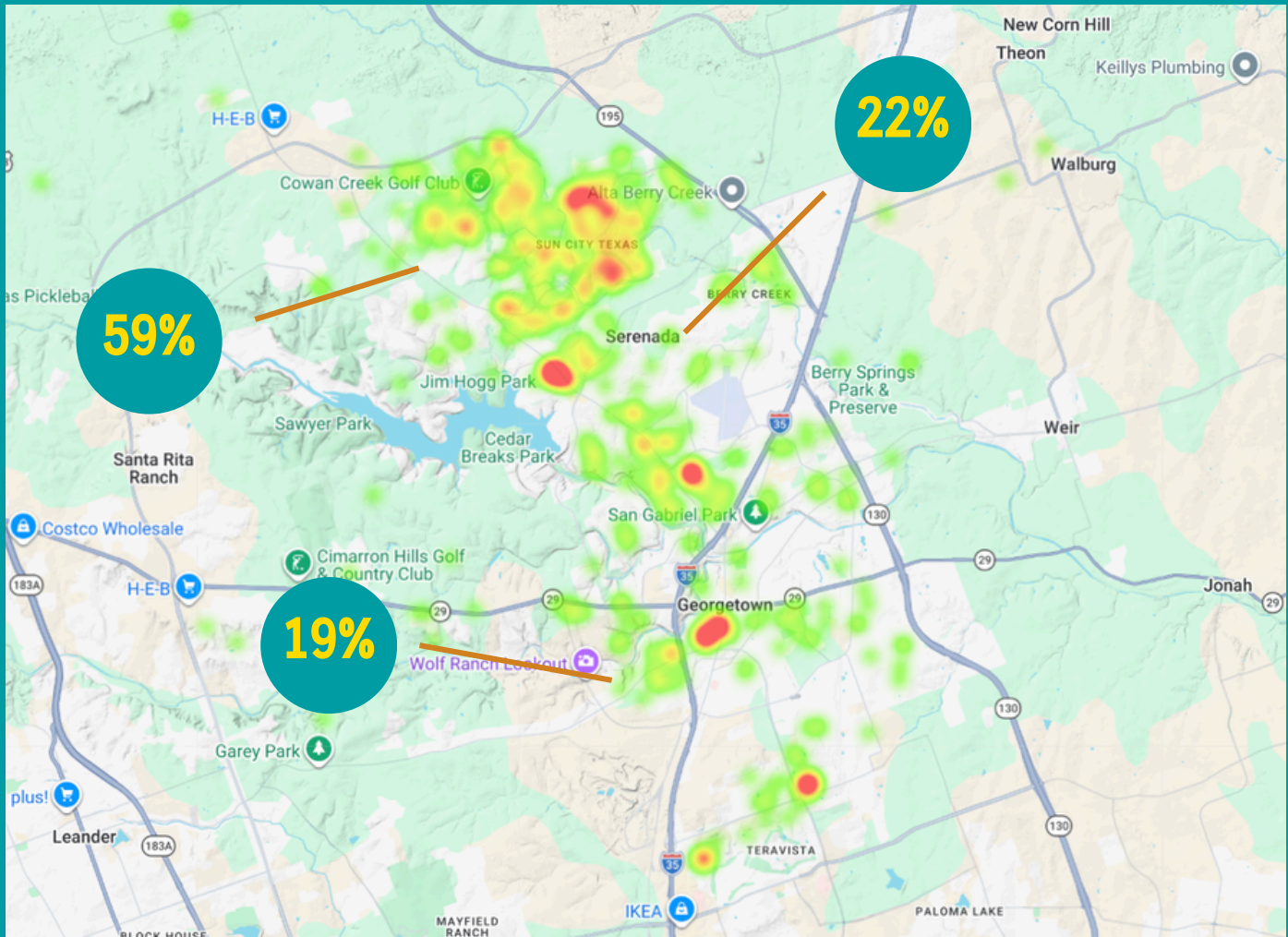

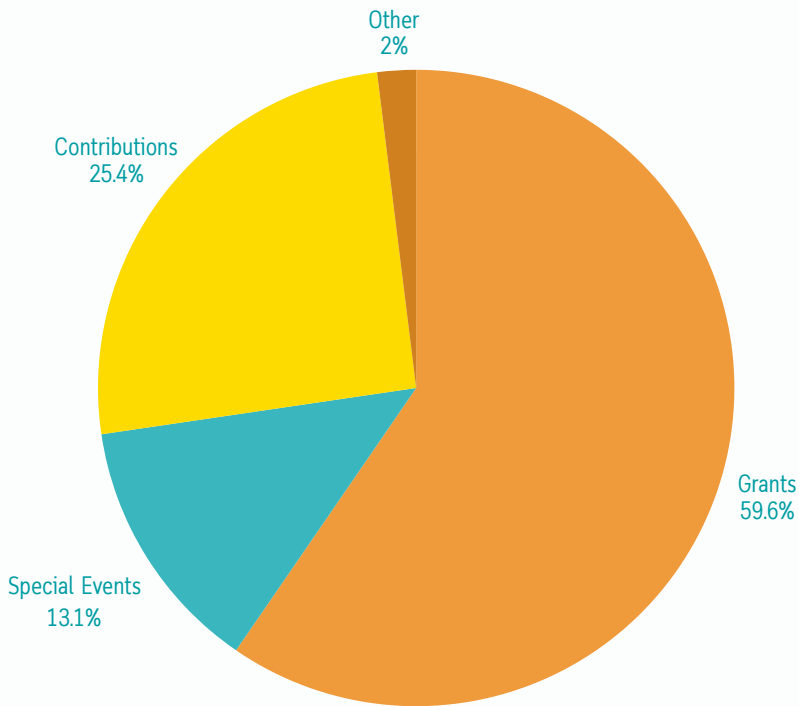
SERVING SENIORS ACROSS GREATER GEORGETOWN

FIAG proudly serves seniors age 65 and older living in Georgetown and surrounding areas. Our services are available to anyone within an eight-mile radius of our office, including communities within the city’s Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ).

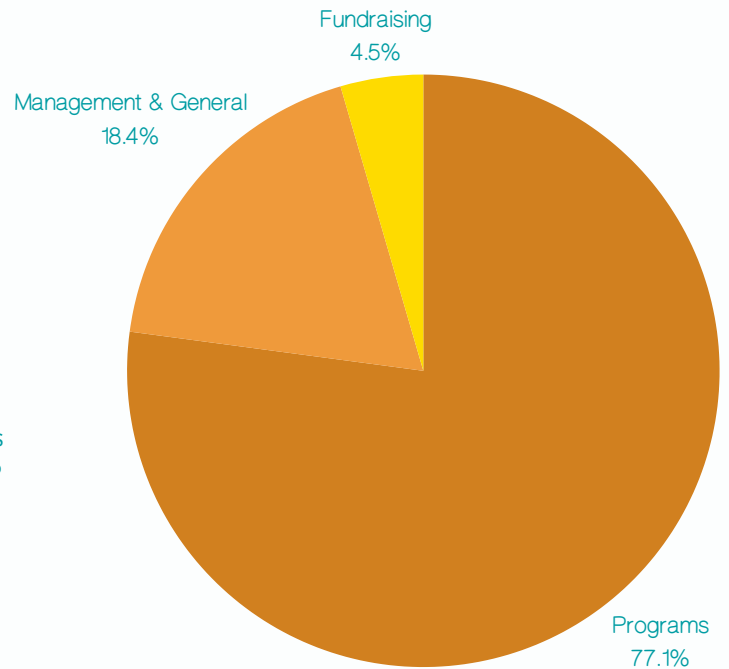
In 2025, FIAG supported 839 seniors, reflecting both the growing needs of our community and our continued commitment to helping older adults remain safe, connected, and independent. Of those served, 495 clients resided in the 78633 zip code, 184 in 78628, and 160 in 78626, underscoring FIAG’s broad reach throughout the Georgetown area.

These numbers represent more than statistics—they represent neighbors, friends, and family members whose quality of life is strengthened through FIAG’s services and community partnerships.
