In 2024, Faith in Action Georgetown experienced a year marked by growth, strengthened impact, and deepened community connections. We began the year with a thoughtful restructuring of roles and responsibilities, creating a more focused and strategic team. While many of these adjustments occurred behind the scenes, they significantly improved our efficiency, communication, and ability to serve our mission. Throughout the year, we remained actively engaged in Georgetown's vibrant community and were honored to serve on the City's Transportation Advisory Committee. We could be seen connecting with Sun City's Red Hat Ladies, participating in the Carver Center's back-to-school event, driving in the Christmas Stroll Parade,

celebrating National Night Out, and joining the festivities at Fiesta Georgetown. These events reflect our core belief: meaningful relationships—with clients, volunteers, partners, and neighbors—are central to who we are.

In 2024, we provided nearly 14,000 rides, creating thousands of opportunities for older adults to attend medical appointments, shop for groceries, and experience valuable social interactions with our volunteers. Remarkably, our volunteers provided more rides this year with fewer people—demonstrating their unwavering dedication, compassion, and generosity.

Our major events also experienced tremendous success, including our 4th Annual Portraits of Independence and our 23rd Annual Choral Concert. We expanded our educational and enrichment programs for clients by offering Brain Health sessions, art classes, a tour of a Magic Center (complete with a wonderful magic show), Fraud and Scam Prevention workshops, Chair Fit Bingo, and other engaging activities designed to support independence and well-being.

As we reflect on 2024, we are proud of the progress we have made and the meaningful connections that continue to define our work. Together, we look forward to building on this year's momentum and continuing to make a positive impact in the year ahead.


