2022 was a year of firsts and a year of continuing to meet needs in our ever-growing community! It was my first year with Faith in Action Georgetown. The first few weeks and months were a bit of a blur as I learned everything I could about Faith in Action and began my relationship with its incredible team. I met many clients and volunteers and integrated into the nonprofit culture that I have grown

to love so much. This community is such a community of givers, and it is evident in the vast array of nonprofit organizations that exist simply to help others and meet needs in Georgetown. Our van hit the road with continued grocery rides and the return of social outings in March. By the end of the year, there were fewer and fewer seats available as Social Outing Thursdays became the most popular day of the week for van rides. Clients enjoyed trips to the library, The Caring Place, Wolf Ranch for shopping, and everyone's favorite, the monthly lunch outings!

2022 was the first year that Georgetown became the fastest growing city of its size in the entire nation! We felt it as the need for our services grew at an even greater rate. Our volunteers continued to be the backbone of Faith in Action and really went the extra mile with their one-on-one rides, increasing by 57% over 2021. The year ended with nearly 8,000 rides for our clients!

For the first time, our 21st Annual Choral Concert included a group from the Georgetown Police Department who wowed everyone with their talent. And we were thrilled to honor our clients again through our 2nd Annual Portraits of Independence event where six portraits featuring our clients were on display and two veterans were interviewed.

The year also brought two great new additions to our Faith in Action team. Jennifer Cunningham began as our Director of Marketing and Events and hit the ground running by joining us at the incredibly busy Georgetown Boo Bash on her very first day. We are happy to report, she came back for day two! And Becky Lanclos who had served for years as a Faith in Action Volunteer, officially joined our team as the face of Faith in Action at the reception desk.

Faith in Action could not exist without the commitment of its dedicated volunteers, the incredible generosity of its financial supporters, and the talent and abilities of its amazing team in the office. We are grateful every day to have the honor and privilege of serving older adults in the Georgetown community with more than just a ride...we provide a relationship. It takes a village, and ours is the best!

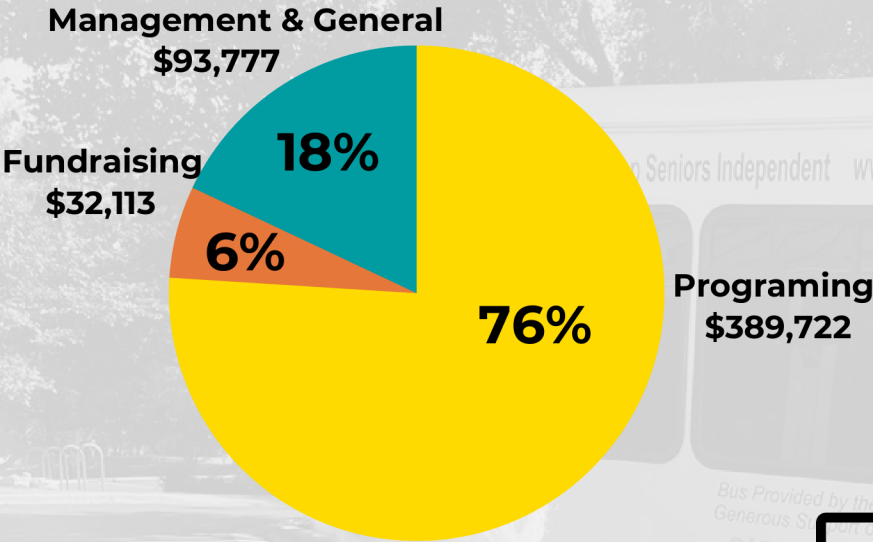

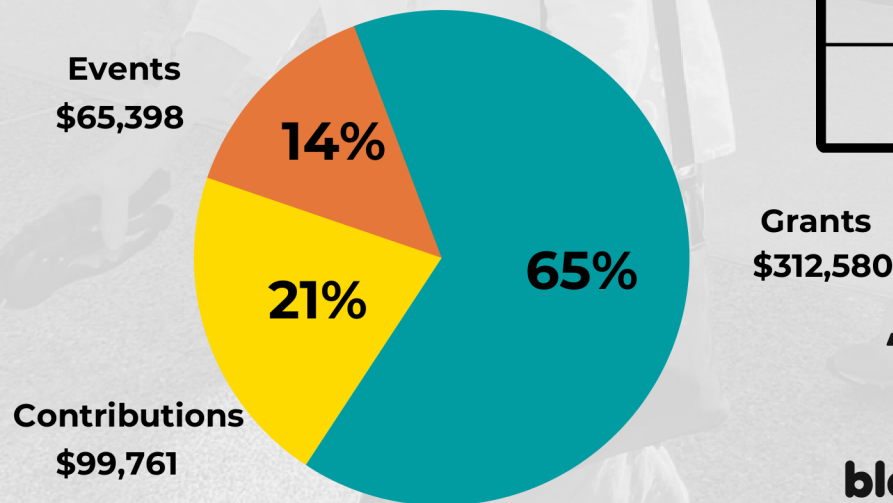
